Critical Facility Needs



Due to our facilities being used well in helping the community, critical facility needs have become glaringly apparent. Local contractors faithfully do surface repairs in their efforts to slow down the inevitable needed major repair. We are so appreciative of them!

Critical Facility Repair/Replacement Costs:

- ~The two roofs are 18 years old. (\$74,000)
- ~The four AC units range from 10 to 20 years old. (\$39,000)
- ~Repaving the parking lot. If you've driven on it, you know the need! (\$50,000)

BIG NEWS REGARDING THESE NEEDS!

We have applied for the "Local Support Grants Program," a new initiative through the Florida Legislature. **State Representative Dana Trubusy** is advocating for GraceWay Village regarding this funding. Her efforts for our neighbors in need are greatly appreciated! If we receive this grant, it will propel us towards meeting the above needs. One requirement needs noted: The total cost of capital improvements listed above (\$163,000) must have 50% (\$82,500) covered by matching funds. As of October, pledges and donations to that end equal \$37,000. To all who have stepped up towards this need, **THANK YOU SO MUCH!**

In order to get all of these critical needs met, an additional \$45,500 is needed in pledges and donations designated for these repairs. Accomplishing this goal will release other saved funds directly to feeding the hungry and clothing children. **Please consider joining us in this effort to meet critical needs in the most cost-effective manner that will protect funds for continued help to our neighbors in need.**
