The economic crisis for the middle to low income St. Lucie County residents has shown the commitment level of care from the heart of all who partner in service and support with GraceWay Village.

St. Lucie County greatly benefits from the work done through the programs.

- · The GWV Café expects to provide over 65,000 hot meals free to local neighbors in need.
- Over 1,500 hot meals are provided each week to individuals and families with children.
- The Children/Teens Clothing Boutique expects to clothe over 2,300 children in 2022.
