#### Message from GWV Operations Manager, **Chrissie Hoeffner**



### DID YOU KNOW?

- . A total of 35% of the households, just in St. Lucie County alone, fall into the ALICE category (Asset, Limited, Income Considered, Employed), indicating that they have jobs but struggle to afford basic needs.
- The Federal Poverty level equals an income below \$15,060 for a single-person household and below \$31,200 for a four-person household.
- St. Lucie Co. approximately 45% totaling 12,534 people living below the ALICE threshold.
- St. Lucie County has a food insecure population of 9.5% totaling 30,850 people
- In St. Lucie County, out of 338 people experiencing homelessness, 52 are children, and 313 are unsheltered. Additionally, there are 1792 individual households classified as "couch surfers" indicating those are temporarily staying with others.
- In St. Lucie, the Fair Market Rate for rent is 95% higher than other areas and has increased by over .33% in the last year People living on one low-wage salary in St. Lucie County would have to work 132 hours per week just to pay their rent. The average rent in St. Lucie County is approximately \$1700 per month. At this rate, most of the people in our community are spending more than half of their monthly income on housing.

Since 2009, GraceWay Village has been serving neihbors in need by providing hot meals to those that are hungry and clothing necessities to children
